STEP 1: Have a Passion for Birth and/or Babies!

That's all you need! Everything else, we will teach you. You will finish the course feeling so confident to get out into your community as a doula!

STEP 2: Apply for Doula Training

This typically takes 3 minutes to fill out the online application. You will then need to wait typically 1-2 days for the admissions counselor to review your application and call you.

STEP 3: Admissions Interview

Although there are no training or professional prerequisites to becoming a doula, there is a short admissions interview required. This allows the certification program to ensure a good fit for the program and doula work. The main component an admissions counselor wants to see in an applicant is a passion for pregnancy, childbirth and/or after birth.

STEP 4: Select a Payment Plan and Make your First Payment

International Doula Institute offers a number of different payment plans so that finances don't have to stop you from pursuing your dream of becoming a doula. Once you make your very first payment, you have immediate access to begin the course work. Many students are able to finish the program before they even make their last payment!
